A checklist to ensure your generous donation can be used.

Starlight greatly appreciates the kind donation of non-monetary goods and services from supporters which make an enormous difference to the delivery and evolution of Starlight's innovative hospital and community programs. Donations to Starlight will support the seriously ill children and young people in hospital and in the community that need it most.

To ensure that your gift will comply with hospital regulations and benefit sick kids in Starlight's programs, please review the below guidelines which offer a general standard for the types of items which are best suited for donation.

We can accept:

- Toys which are brand new, unopened and still in their original packaging
- Computers, tablets, MP3 players, gaming consoles which are brand new, unopened and still in their original packaging
- Newly or recently released CDs, DVDs and computer games which will ensure kids in our programs feel they aren't missing out on things currently trending
- Brand new furniture items such as a bed which may be suitable for a bedroom makeover
- All unperishable food items which are still within their use by date

We cannot accept:

- Used toys, computer games or CDs etc due to the delicate health of sick kids
- R Rated DVDs or computer games which contain explicit language or use of heavy guns and warfare which are inappropriate for young kids in Starlight's programs
- Guns or warfare items which are considered inappropriate for children in our in-hospital programs
- Items affiliated with a particular or specific religion which Starlight are unable to accept given we are a non-denominational charity
